The April meeting of the board directors of McLean Electric Cooperative Inc. was held at the Cooperative's headquarters in Garrison, North Dakota, on the 22nd day of April, 2021. The meeting was called to order by President Larry Gessele at 9:00 o'clock a.m.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the Consent Agenda which consisted of additional agenda items, review of directors checks, approval of the membership and service applications/transfers, and the minutes of the March 25, 2021, board meeting. The motion carried.

The estate of Hulda Mehlhoff was presented for capital credit retirement. A motion was made and seconded to retire the capital credits for the estate. The motion carried.

The board reviewed a bad debt to be written off. A question was made as to whether the bad debt could be paid out of the existing capital credits for the account. A motion was made and seconded to table discussion to the May meeting.
